Washer Pitch Rules

Cup like goals are inserted into the ground 21 feet apart. The washers have a 2_-inch outside

diameter and the cups or goals, made of metal or plastic, have an outside diameter of 3_ inches.

Each player has 4 washers. For the first round, a coin toss determines which player pitches first. After that, the winner of each round goes first on the next round. A player pitches all 4 washers before the opponent pitches.

A player stands even with or behind the goal cup when pitching toward the other goal. The object is simply to pitch the washer into the cup. That would net five points and it's called a ringer.

If the washer hangs over the hole, it's called a leaner and scores three points. Whichever washer is closest to the hole scores one point. If one player has 1, 2, 3 or all 4 washers closest to the hole, that player scores 1, 2, 3 or 4 points as appropriate.

Only one player is allowed to score per round and the first to get 21 points is the winner.

Houston Pumpkin Festival Tournament Rules:

There will be singles and double matches. Singles matches will take place after conclusion of the doubles matches.

There will be 5 courts. Players or teams will be assigned numbers and initial match play will be determined by random number drawing.

Singles: A match will consist of best two out of three games and players switch ends after each game. Matches will be double elimination with losers going to a loser bracket and the winner of the loser bracket playing the winner of the winner bracket until a final winner is determined.

NOTE: In the losers bracket there will be one game only – not best two out of three.

Doubles: A match will consist of best two out of three games and players switch ends after each game.

Matches will be double elimination with losers going to a loser bracket and the winner of the loser bracket playing the winner of the winner bracket until a final winner is determined.

NOTE: In the losers bracket there will be one game only – not best two out of three.

A skunk rule of 11 to 0 is in effect for each game.

Disputes concerning closest to the hole will be settled by the tournament director if players cannot resolve to mutual satisfaction (i.e. No points and re-pitch).

Trophies will be given to winners of first and second place in the singles and doubles matches
